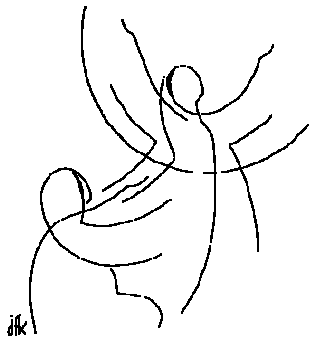

All the days of my life ;

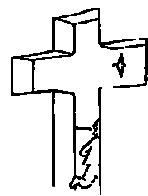
And I shall dwell in the house of the Lord

 you restored our life.

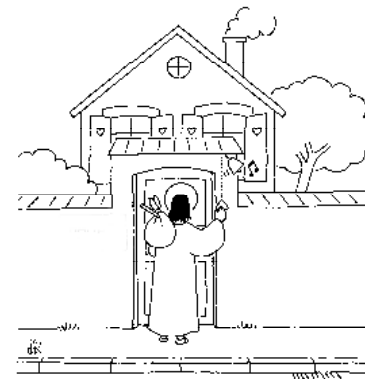
Lord Jesus,
