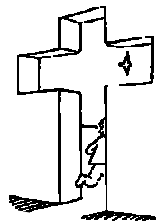
Springs of water, bless the Lord ! Give him praise and glory for ever !

 Reading of the Holy Gospel according to John (14:15-21)

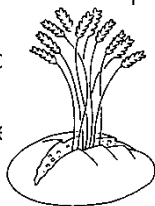
*Chorus :*
