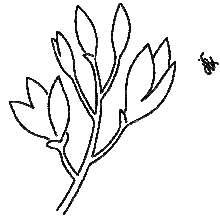
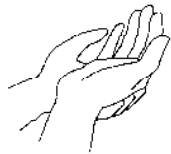

And contemplate his temple.**

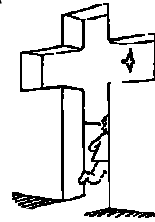
